

- Observed in Memory of Christ
 - Luke 22:19; 1 Corinthians 15:1-4
- Man Can Be Forgetful
 - Jeremiah 2:32
 - Ecclesiastes 12:1
 - 2 Peter 3:1

 - 1 Corinthians 10:17




The Lord's Supper Is a Proclamation

- Ephesians 1:3




The Lord's Supper Is An Anticipation
