#### I Am Resolved

### Introduction

**Text: Philippians 2:5-8** 

- 1. We all can relate to important milestones in our lives usually by stating the year that these things occurred. For example:
  - A. High school graduation; College graduation; Marriage; Children's birth; Baptism, etc.
    - 1) Perhaps there is something that we will remember more about this year than other years.
- 2. The title of our lesson this morning is "I Am Resolved." What is a resolution? There are at least four definitions of this word, but the one that we want to look at this morning is the following:
  - A. Resolution: "a firm decision to do or not to do something."

## I Am Resolved No Longer To Linger In The World

- 1. We may desire to "linger" at times.
  - A. Distractions, slowing down to make observations, to investigate.
- 2. Resolve to not be charmed by the world's delights.
  - A. Examples of appeal of the world.
    - Peer pressure, Success, Power, Wealth.
       Matthew 26:41

- 3. Lingering is a result of our own desires.
  - A. For example: In Walmart, I may linger in the hardware department while my wife lingers in the craft section. In whatever area appeals to me, that is where I want to linger.
    - 1) If there is no appeal, then there is no lingering.
  - B. Sin is the same way. That which is appealing to one then there is the real temptation and danger of lingering there.

    Romans 7:22-8:1

Romans 13:14 But put on the Lord Jesus Christ, and make no provision for the flesh, to fulfill its lusts.

#### I Am Resolved To Follow The Savior

- 1. We must live faithful and true to God each day.
  - A. Let's take it one day at a time making each day about Him.

Matthew 6:34 Therefore do not worry about tomorrow, for tomorrow will worry about its own things. Sufficient for the day is its own trouble.

- B. We also need to be honest with ourselves each day.

  James 1:23-25
- 2. Being faithful to God is the only way that we can follow Jesus.

Hebrews 5:8-9 Romans 6:16-18

3. We must start with obedience from the heart.

Proverbs 3:1-4

A. If we are not obedient when we are alone, are we really following our Savior?

#### I Am Resolved To Enter The Kingdom

- 1. Most people have never obeyed the gospel.
  - A. In order to gain salvation one must be resolved to "enter the kingdom."
  - B. One must be "added to the church" which also places them "in the kingdom."

Acts 2:41 Then those who gladly received his word were baptized; and that day about three thousand souls were added to them.

Acts 2:47 praising God and having favor with all the people. And the Lord added to the church daily those who were being saved.

- 2. Most of us in attendance today have been baptized for the forgiveness of our sins but we now must resolve to remain in the kingdom.
  - A. Apostasy is a fact that is taught in Scripture. Good men who were once right with God fell away:
    - 1) Judas, Demas, Hymaneus, and Philetus
  - B. Therefore, apostasy is a possibility for you and me.
    - 1) Don't assume salvation just because we "understand" God's doctrine.
    - 2) Apostasy is inevitable IF we stop applying the truth.
    - 3) If the apostle Paul had to "keep himself" how much more should we be certain of our remaining in the kingdom?

#### C. Causes of apostasy:

1) Loving the present world.

2 Timothy 4:10 for Demas has forsaken me, having loved this present world, and has departed for Thessalonica.....

2) Shutting up our ears to truth and learning.

Acts 7:54-57

3) Resisting the truth.

2 Thessalonians 2:9-10

2 Timothy 4:8 Finally, there is laid up for me the crown of righteousness, which the Lord, the righteous Judge, will give to me on that Day, and not to me only but also to all who have loved His appearing.

- D. Safeguards that work against apostasy:
  - 1) God's Word.

2 Timothy 3:13-17

2) Spiritual Growth.

2 Peter 1:5-11

3) Being grounded in the truth.

**Ephesians 4:13-16** 

4) Putting on the armor of God and using it wisely.

**Ephesians 6:10-20**
